Installation time

The installation time is **approx. 0.5 hours**. This may vary depending on the condition of the car and the equipment in it.

The installation time shown does not include any time spent on programming / coding.

The calculation of the total costs for the programming time must be factored into the calculation of retrofitting costs (no charges may be made through the warranty).

Important information

These installation instructions are primarily designed for use within the BMW dealership organisation and by authorised BMW service companies.

In any event the target group for these installation instructions is specialist personnel trained on MINI cars with the appropriate specialist knowledge.

All work must be completed using the latest BMW repair manuals, wiring diagrams, servicing manuals and work instructions, in a rational order, using the prescribed tools (special tools) and observing current health and safety regulations.

If you experience installation or function problems, restrict troubleshooting to approx. 0.5 hours for mechanical work and 1.0 hour for electrical work.

To avoid unnecessary extra work and/or costs, send an inquiry straight away to the technical parts support team via the Aftersales Assistance Portal (ASAP).

Quote the following information:

- Vehicle identification number,
- Retrofit kit part number,
- A detailed description of the problem,
- Any work already carried out.

Do not archive the hard copy of these installation instructions since daily updates are provided via ASAP!

Installation information

Ensure that the cables and/or lines are not kinked or damaged as you install them in the car. Costs arising from this will not be reimbursed by BMW AG.

Additional cables/wires that you install must be secured with cable ties. If the specified PIN chambers are occupied, bridges, double crimps or twin-lead terminals must be used.

All pictures show LHD cars; proceed accordingly on RHD cars.

Installation is shown only on the left-hand side of the car; proceed in the same way on the right-hand side of the car.

The car may be driven after **approx. 6 hours** and may be taken through a car wash after **approx. 48 hours**.

Ordering instructions

The Betalink is not included in the retrofit kit and must be ordered separately (see EPC for part number and further details).







2. Preparatory work

The following components must be removed first of all	ISTA No.
Conduct a brief test	
Disconnect the negative pole of the battery	12 00
Remove the left and right indicator lights	



The areas being bonded must be completely dry, clean and free from wax or grease.

Apply Betalink (1) as shown on the front of decorative finisher **A**.


Insert indicator (1) into decorative finisher **A** and press on firmly until the indicator (1) engages.

The areas being bonded must be completely dry, clean and free from wax or grease.

Clean the bonding surface (1) with suitable agents.


Place decorative finisher **A** on the wing and position it until the indicator on decorative finisher **A** is located noticeably low down on the bodywork.


Position edge (1) parallel to edge (2) with a distance of **approx. 2-3 mm**.



After positioning, stick on a positioning aid using suitable adhesive tape (4).

Remove decorative finisher A.






Apply Betalink (1) as shown on the reverse of decorative finisher **A**.

Connect the indicator on decorative finisher **A** to the indicator cable.

Remove any Betalink that oozes out immediately. ◀

Place decorative finisher **A** on the wing and, using adhesive tape (1), position it until the indicator on decorative finisher **A** is located noticeably low down on the bodywork.

The distance from edge (2) to edge (3) must be **approx. 2-3 mm**.



Press decorative finisher **A** firmly onto the wings.

Secure decorative finisher **A** using suitable adhesive tape (1).

Remove the adhesive tape (2).

4. Concluding work and coding

The retrofit system does not require coding.

- Connect the battery
- Conduct a brief test
- Conduct a function test
- Re-assemble the car in a logical manner
