Spark Plug Change DIY

Tools you'll need:

Ratchet

6" extension (I used a 3", but would have been better to use a 6") 5/8" spark plug socket



Locate the spark plug wires (they are toward the backside of the intercooler and there are 4).



Pull the first plug wire from the passenger side (pull one at a time so you don't lose track of which wire goes to which plug.



View down the hole.



Insert the spark plug socket with the extension on it into the hole. Make sure it clicks down around the plug, insert the ratchet and loosen until you can pull it out. Make sure there is a ring around the base of the plug and that it isn't in the hole. You can use an extendable magnet if it came off.



View after plug is removed.



Insert the new plug into the socket and lower it down into the hole. Make sure you thread it properly before you tighten it down.

Repeat the process for the next three plugs.
