

# Airbag Sticker Removal from '09 Clubman

\* as with all things in life, **you** are responsible for any and all damage that may occur during this project and the outcome! If you are prone to whining, sniveling or blaming others for a project gone wrong, then do not proceed. If you feel confident in your abilities, I'd give this project a "0" on difficulty. Total project time was ½ hour from start to finish.



1. I removed the visor from the car using a thin pocket knife. I found that if you push at least 1/4" in and then try to pop out the screw cover it does not hurt the plastic. CAUTION! After unscrewing the visor do not forget that it is attached to wires for the visor lights. Gently pull down and then unplug the visor.



2. Picture of driver visor with sticker. My visor is vinyl, so don't know if this will work on fabric visors.



3. After reading the forums, I went with the dry-erase solution over the others as it seemed to have some good feedback. I folded a paper towel to the size of the sticker and then soaked the towel and placed it on the sticker.



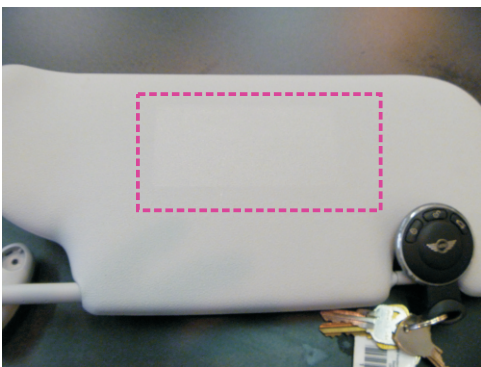
4. Most of the forums said to place some sort of weight on the towel to press it into the sticker. I had a 25lb weight laying around, so I used it. Probably overkill but it worked. Figure a brick or some books would do just as well.



5. After about 10 minutes I took the weight / paper towel combo off and using a thin set of tweezers I was able to gently scrape the edge of the sticker and then pull it up.



6. After getting a good amount up, I was able to gently pull back on the sticker. It is very rubbery and if you just use a little tension, it will pull up. Do not pull too hard as it breaks.



7. After removing the sticker, I sprayed some solution and GENTLY used a sponge with the green side to get the excess glue that was left. You can see the slight area where the sticker was. My car is an '09, so a couple years of fading probably.



8. The finished product! No more ugly yellow stickers!
