Care instructions


Protective bootspace cover ${\bf A}$ and extension ${\bf B}$ are machine-washable up to 30 °C or must be cleaned using MINI plastic cleaner.

Please refer to the following symbols on the tag:


- 1. Normal wash at 30 °C.
- 2. Chlorine bleaching not possible.
- 3. Do not iron.
- 4. Chemical cleaning not possible.
- 5. Not suitable for tumble dryers.

Wash protective bootspace cover ${\bf A}$ and extension ${\bf B}$ separately.

Under no circumstances should you use solvents such as varnish thinners, cold cleaner or fuel.




Figs. 3 – 10 Protective bootspace cover Figs. 11 – 18 Extension of protective bootspace cover


Remove the combination roller blind (1).



Adapt protective cover **A** to the contours of the car's trim. Join the Velcro strips (1) together.




Snap the rubber band (1) of the protective cover **A** from the rear seat over the headrest (2).




Working from the middle, push rods ${\bf D}$ into the pockets of protective cover ${\bf A}$ and join them together. Make sure the thin ends are pointing towards the outside.







Clamp rod ${\bf D}$ in the area (1) between the trim components.




Close the zip fasteners (1) at the sides. If necessary, tuck the tabs (2) under the floor of the bootspace.




If required, first insert the combination roller blind (1) and then clamp rod ${\bf D}$ in the area between the trim components (2).




Remove the floor covering (1).




Fold the rear seat backrest (1) down.




Adapt protective cover **A** to the contours of the car's trim.




Hook the hooks (1) of protective cover **A** into the openings.




Join protective cover $\bf A$ together with expansion $\bf B$ at the Velcro strips. Now press the suction cups (1,2,3) into the bottom corners on the side windows.




Hook the reinforced tabs (1) of extension ${\bf B}$ in between the rods (2) of the headrests.



Open the Velcro-type fasteners (1) and spread protective cover **A** towards the bootspace well if required.



Close the zip fasteners (1) at the sides. If necessary, tuck the tabs (2) under the floor of the bootspace.



If required, first insert the combination roller blind (1) and then clamp rod ${\bf D}$ in the area between the trim components (2).
